
MISSION FROM GONDWANA

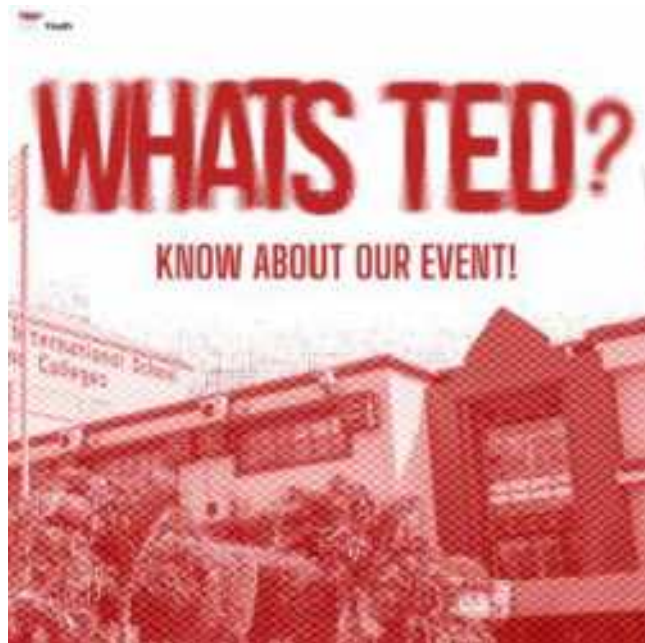

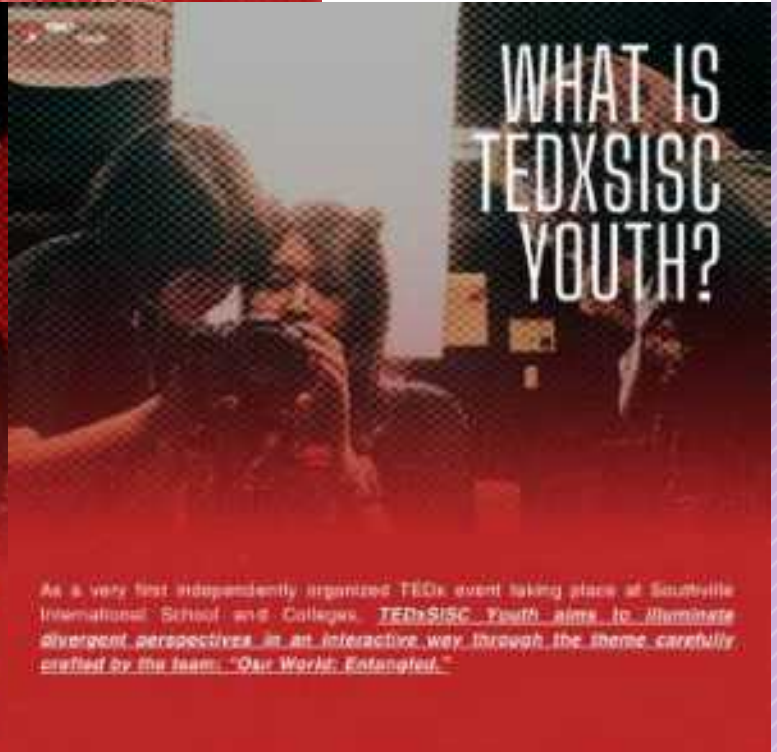

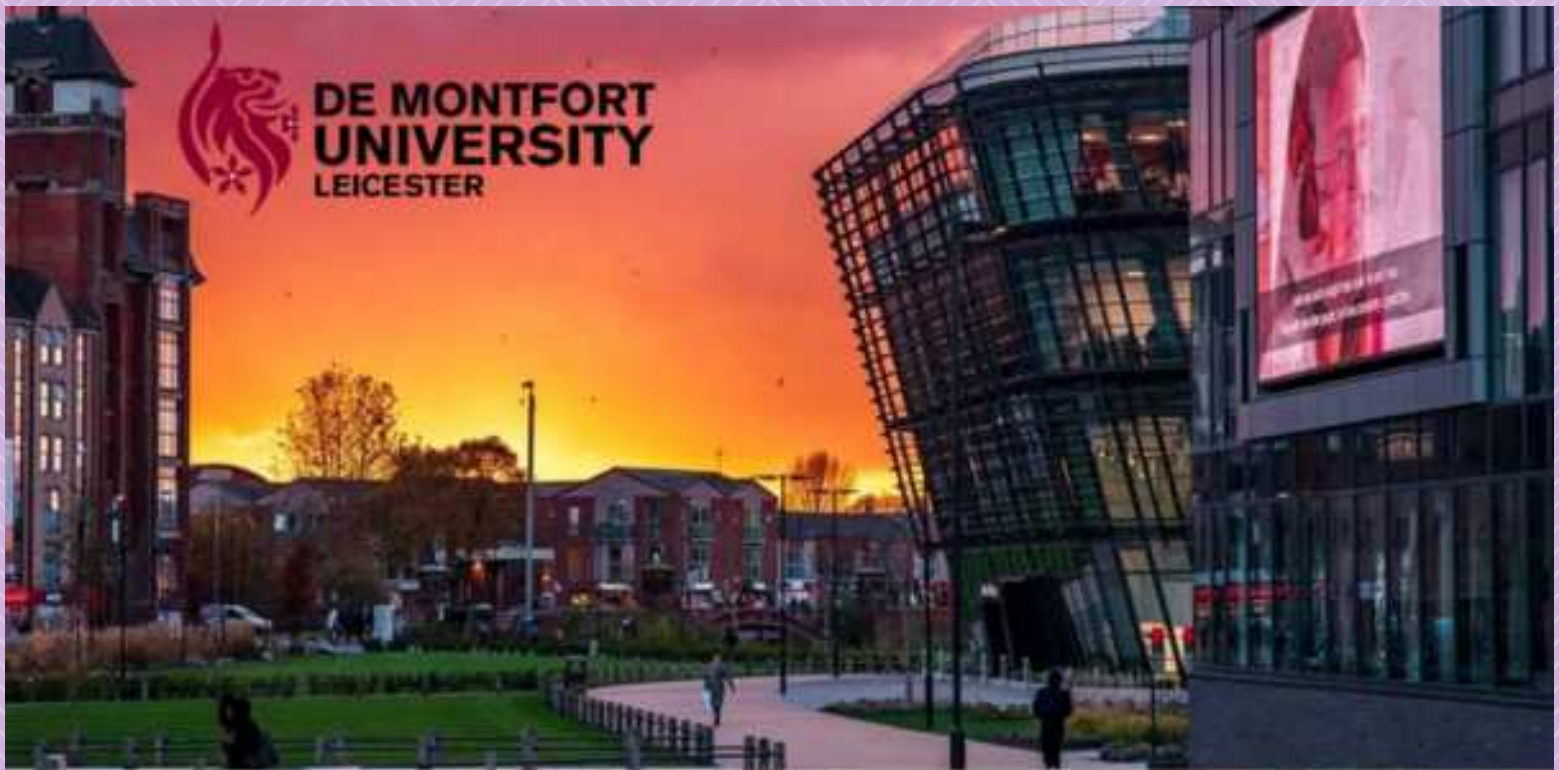
