- **College Board's Digital SAT (Test Center Code: 74899)**

These standardized tests play a crucial role in college admissions and educational evaluations, allowing students to excel in a **comfortable and accessible testing environment**.

Additionally, SISC has now been recognized as an official testing center for the **Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi (HSK)**, also known as the **Chinese Language Proficiency Test**. Administered by the **Ministry of Education in China**, the HSK is a globally accepted certification assessing Mandarin proficiency for non-native speakers. It is a **key requirement for university admissions, scholarships, and employment opportunities in China**, with Chinese companies also utilizing HSK scores in their recruitment process.

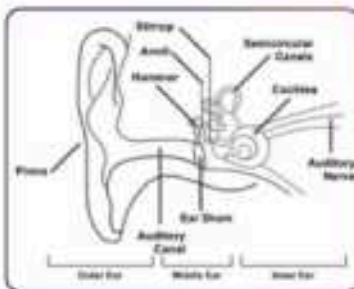

The EAR in CARE

INTERNATIONAL EAR CARE DAY

Your ears are paired organs, located on each side of your head, that are used for hearing and balance.



Functions

Hearing

The process of sound waves vibrates the eardrum, which is amplified by the ossicles and converted into electrical signals by the hair cells in the inner ear, for the brain to interpret.

Balance

Your inner ear's semicircular canals use fluid and hair-like sensors to detect head movement and send balance signals to your brain and muscles.

Common Diseases/Problems

SWIMMERS EAR

This ear canal infection is caused by bacteria or fungi; getting water in your ear can cause this condition.

OTOSCLEROSIS

This disease causes abnormal bone growth in the middle ear, the bones slowly become spongelike (otospongiosis).

HEARING LOSS

Hearing loss refers to a reduced capacity to hear sounds. It can affect one or both ears and varies in intensity.

Ear Care 101

Don't use cotton swabs to clean your ear canal.

Keep your ears dry by wearing ear plugs when swimming.

Turn the volume down when listening to music through headphones.

Wear ear plugs if you're around loud noises.

Go to doctor in case of ear pain discharge or any difficulty in hearing
